WE WOULD LIKE TO THANK YOU MOST SINCERBLY FOR GIVING US THE OPPORTUNITY TO ADDRESS THIS 46TH SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AS IT DISCUSSES THE QUESTION OF SOUTH AFRICA.

WE SAY THIS BECAUSE WE ARE ACUTZLY AWARE AND DEEPLY APPRECIATIVE OF 252 ROLE THAT THIS ORGANISATION HAS PLAYED SINCE ITS FOUNDATION IN THE STRUGGLE FOR THE EMANCIPAQION OF OUR PEOPLE FROM THE TYRANNY OF RACIAL OPPRESSION.

WE MEET HERE TODAX SHORTLY BEFORE THE POLITICAL FORMATIONS OF OUR COUNQRY GATHER TOGETHER IN A "CONVENTION FOR A DEMOCRATIC SOUTH AFRICA", TO BEGIN THE PROCESS THAT WILL LEAD TO THE ADOPTION OF A DEMOCRATIC CONSTITUTION.

AS OUR COUNTRY STARTS ON ITS FINAL LAP TOWARDS THE .REALISATION OF THE GOALS ENSHRINED IN THE UN CHARTER, THE DECLAEATION ON HUMAN RIGHTS AS WELL AS THE DECLARATION ON SOUTH AFRICA ADOPTED BY THIS ASSEMBLY TWO YEARS AGO THIS MONTH, THE LEADERSKIP OF THE ANC THOUGHT THAT IT WAS IMPORQANT TRAT WE SHOULD COME BACK TO NEW YORK TO SHARE WITH YOU OUR VIEWS ON THE

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SUBJECT or YOUR AGENDA.

MR. PRESIDENT:

THANKS TO THE JOINT arrears or ova PEOPLE AND GOVERNMENTS AND PEOPLES REPRESENTED HERE, SOUTH AFRICA HAS EMEARKED on ITS own RACE mo NORMALITY.

WE CAN SEE RISING ON WAS HORIZON THE NEW GLORIOUS ENTITY WARCA SHALL NO LONGER 32 SPOKEN OR AS THE PARIAH AMONG THE NATIONS, r32 DETESTABLE EXAMPLE OR WHAT IS IMPERMISSIBLE IN THE ORDERING OR HUMAN RELATIONS. WAS HOME LAND OR A CRIME AGAINST HUMANITX.

WE ALSO WANT TO SEE ENTRENCXED ALI- THE NECESSARY PROVISIONS ENSURING THE FULLEST POSSIBLE PROZBCTION AND ADVANCEMENT OF THE

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FUNDAMENTAL HUMAN RIGHTS OF EVERY SOUTH AFRICAN CITIZEN. AS PART OF THIS AND TO ENSURE THE RULE OF LAW, THERE WILL HAVE TO BE CREATED AN INDEPENDENT AND NON-RACIAL JUDICIARY, AS VISUALISED IN EARLIER DOCUMENTS ADOPTED 8! THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY. AT THE SAME TIME, THE NEW SOUTH AFRICA WILL HAVE TO ADDRESS THE BURNING QUESTION 03 MASS POVERTY, WHICH AFPLICTS MILLIONS OF OUR PEOPLE, ESPECIALLY THE BLACK POPULATION. ALSO TO BE DBALT WITH AS A MATTER OF URGENCY ARE, OF COURSE, QUESTIONS OF THE GROSS RACIAL IMBALANCES IN THE DISTRIBUTION OF INCOME, WEALTH, LAND AN? OPPORTUNITY.

IT IS COMMON CAUSE AMONG THE MAJORITY OF OUR PEOPLE THAT THE POLITICAL SETTLEMENT WE SEEK TO RSACK CANNOT SURVIVE FOR VERY LONG IF THESE QUESTIONS, RELATING TO THE STANDARD OF LIVING OF THE PEOPLE AS A waonz AND THE QUALITY OF LIFE, ARE NOT ADDRESSED. fhat is why the issue of the growth of the economy and its RESTRUCTURING TO SERVE THE NEEDS OF THE ENTIRE POPULATION, HAS TO BE AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE PROCESS OF THE RECONSTRUCTION OF SOUTH AFRICA AS A PEMOCRATIC, PEACEEUL AND STABLE COUNTRY. THE NEW SOUTE AFRICA WILL, OF COURSE, SEEK TO NORMALISE ITS RELATIONS WIT3 THE REST OF THE WORLD. IN THIS CONTEXT, WE MUST MAKE THE POINT TBA! WE FULLY RESPECT THE POSITION SPELT OUT IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY CORSENSUS DECLARATION ON SOUTH AFRICA, CONCERNING THE CONDITIONS THAT OUR COUNTRY MUST MEET, TO PROVIDE THE BASIS FOR AN INTERNATIONALLY ACCEPTABLE SOLUTION OF THE SOUTH AIRICAN QUESTION AND FOR ITS FULL INTEGRATION AMONG THE COMMUNITY OF NATIONS .

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SUCH INTEGRATION WOULD UNDOUBTEDLY HAVE TO TAKE FULL ACCOUNT OF THE FACT THAT WE ARE AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE REGION OF SOUTHERN AFRICA AND AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE CONTINENT OF AFRICA. IN A WORLD IN WHICH REGIONAL ASSOCIATIONS OF VARIOUS KINDS HAVE BECOME AN IMPORTANT PART OF THE SYSTEM OF INTERNATIONAL 38LATIONS, THE NEW SOUTH AFRICA WILL SEEK TO BRING WHATEVER IT CAN TO THE PROCESS OF STRENGTHENING BOTH THE REGION OF SOUTHERN AFRICA AND OUR CONTINENT A5 A WHOLE.

BUT OF COURSE, THE REALITY IS THAT WE HKVE NOT YET LIBERATED OUR COUNTRY. IT IS STILL RULED BY A WHITE MINORITY REGIME, UNDER AN APARTHEID CONSTITUTION. THEREFORE WE ARE FACED WITR THE CONTINUING CHALLENGE TO PURSUE THE STRUGGLE UNTIL FREEDOM IS WON. IT HAS NOW BEEN AGREED THAT T83 "CONVENTION FOR A DEMOCRATIC SOUTK AIRICA", T9 WHICH WE HAVE REFERRED SHOULD BE HELD AS OF THE 20TH OF THIS MONTH. THIS WILL MARK AN IMPORTANT STEP FORWARD IN THE PROCESS LEADING TO A NEGOTIATED RESOLUTION OF THE POLITICAL PROBLEMS RACING OUR COUNTRY.

AS YOU %RE UNDOUBTEDLY AWARE, THE CONVENTION WILL DISCUSS SUCH MATTERS AS THE PRINCIPLES TEA! WILL UNDERLIE THE NEW CONSTITUTION, THE MECHANISM TO DRAW U? THIS CONSTITUTION. AN INTERIM GOVERNMENT THAT WILL TAKE CHARGE 0? THE COUNTRY UNTIL A NEW DEMOCRATICALLY ELECTED GOVERNMENT IS FORMED, THE REINCORPORATION OF THE BANTUSIANS INTO SOUTH AFRICA, THE TIME FRAMES FOR THE TRANSITIONAL PERIOD AS A WHOLE, AND IKE ROLE OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY.

AS YOU CAN SEE, THESE A52 ALL VERY IM?ORTANT MATTERS ON

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WHICH WE WILL SEEK SPEEDY DECISIONS.

THAT THE DECISIONS OF THE CONVENTION WILL BE GIVEN LEGAL FORCE. UNLESS THIS IS DONE, THE CONVENTION WILL BE NO MORE THAN A MERE TALKING SHOP. OBVICUSLY, THIS CANNOT BE ALLOWED.

IN T32 AFTERMATH OF THE CONCLUSION OF THE WORK OF THE CONVENTION, WE WILL NEED TO MOVE AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE TO ESTABLISH THE CONSTITUTION-MAKING BODY.

IN OUR VIEW, THIS SHOULD BE AN ELECTED CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY. ONCE ESEABLISHEDP WE SEE NO REASON WHY THIS ASSEMBLY SHOULD NOT CONCLUDE ITS WORK OF DRAWING UP THE NEW CONSTITUTION WITHIN THE YEAR.

PRECISELY BECAUSE WE HAVE NOT AS YET REACBED THE GOAL 0? LIBERATION TOWARDS WHICH ALL OF US HAVE STRIVEN, WE BELIEVE TEA? TRERE IS NEED FOR CONTINUED INTERNATIONAL PRESSURE TO ENCOURAGE SPEEDY MOVEMENT FORWARD TOWARDS ENDING THE SYSTEM OF APARTKEID. SANCTIONS T3; REFORE CONTINUE TO BE IMPORTANT.

AT THE SAME TIME WE BELIEVE THAT SUCH SANCTIONS SHOULD BE LIFTED IN PHASES CORRESPONDING TO ACTUAL PROGRESS BEING ACHIEVED, WITHIN SOUTH AFRICA. T82 TWO MAJOR PHASES AREAD OF US WOULD BE DELINEATED BY THE ESTABLISHMENT 0? THE INTERIM GOVERNMENT AND SECONDLY, THE ELECTION OF THE NEW GOVERNMENT IN TERMS OF A DEMOCRATIC CONSTITUTION.

WE WOULD THEREFORE URGE TRIS ASSEMBLY AND ITS MEMBER STATES TO HANDLE THE ISSUE OF SANCTIONS :N THIS MANNER. WE ARE

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CCNVINCED THAT THIS IS THE BEST WAY TO USE THIS FORM OF PRESSURE TO REALISE OUR COMMON OBJECTIVE OF SECURING A SPEEDY END TO THE SYSTEM OF APARTHEID. WE APPEAL TO YOU ALL TO REED THE VOICE OF THE OPPRESSED ON THIS MATTER. THEY WHO, AFTER ALL, ASKED YOU TO COME TO THEIR ASSISTANCE BY IMPOSING THESE SANCTIONS.

IT IS ALSO CRITICALLY IMPORTANT THAT THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY SHOULD SUPPORT THE PEACEFUL PROCESS LEADING TO THE DEMOCRATIC TRANSFORMATION OF SOUTH AFRICA. WE ARE PLEASED THAT THE UN AS WELL AS OTHER INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS WILL BE INVITED TO SEND OBSERVERS TO THE CONVENTION FOR A DEMOCRATIC SOUTH AFRICA.

THIS WILL PUT THE PEOPLES OF THE WORLD IN A BETTER POSITION TO HELP DETERMINE THE PRECISE WAYS BY WHICH THEY CAN SUPPORT THE PEACE PROCESS IN OUR COUNTRY. T38 POINT, HOWEVER, ALSO NEEDS TO BE MADE THAT THISIORGANISATION, REPRESENTING THE NATIONS OF THE WORLD, RAB ALWAYS TAKEN A FIRM POSITION AS AN OPPONENT OF APARTHEID IN FAVOUR OF THE PERSPECTIVE SPELT OUT IN ITS OWN CHARTER AND'T3E DECLARATION ON HUMAN RIGHTS.

WE WOULD THEREFORE EXPECT THAT AS IT PARTICIPATES IN THE POLITICAL PROCESSES IN SOUTH AFRICA, IN WHATEVER WA! IT DOES SO, IT WILL BE DOING SO AS A COMBATANT FOR DEMOCRACY, JUSTICE AND PEACE.

MR. PRESIDENT)

YOUR EXCELLENCIES:

YOU ARE ALSO AWARE THAI IN OUR QUEST TO END THE VIOLENCE AGAINST THE PEOPLE, WHIC& HAS THREATENED TO DERAIL THE PEACE

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PROCESS, VARIOUS FORMATIONS IN OUR COUNTRY, INCLUDING THE ANC, SIGNED A NATIONAL PEACE ACCORD ALMOST THREE MONTHS AGO.
THIS IS A VERY IMPORTANT AGREEMENT AND SHOULD CONTRIBUTE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CLIMATE FREE OF VIOLENCE AND THEREFORE CONDUCIVE TO FREE POLITICAL ACTIVITY.

WE WOULD LIKE TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THIS OCCASION TO REITERATE THE CALL WE MADE WHEN WE SIGNED THE PEACE ACCORD, THAT THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY SHOULD TAKE SUCK MEASURES AS IT DEEMS FIT TO CENSURE ARD SANCTION ANY ORGANISATION IN SOUTH AFRICA THAT BY FOMEGTING VIOLENCE, ACTS IN A MANNER CONTRARY TO THE PURPOSE OF THE ACCORD.

THIS WILL GREATLY HELP IN THE PROCESS OF CREATING A CLIMATE FREE OF VIOLENCE, AS WAS VISUALISED IN THE 1&z9 CONSENSUS DECLARAIION ON SOUTB AFRICA.

THE NEW SOUTH AFRICA WILL ALSO NEED TO EMBARK ON AN EXTENSIVE PROGRAM OF SOCIO-ECONOMIC TRANSFORMATION. THIS WILL BE NECESSARY BOTH TO ADDRESS EXISTING NEEDS AND TO ENSURE THE PERMANENCE OF THE DEMOCRATIC POLITICAL OUTCOME OF THE PROCESS OF NEGOTIATIONS.

IT WILL CLEARLY BE IM?OSSIBLE FOR US TO CARRY THROUGE THIS PROGRAMME OF SOCIOPECONOMIC CKANGES BY RELYING EXCLUSIVELY ON OUR OWN RESOURCES. WE WILL TKEREPORE REQUIRE THE SUPPORT OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY. THIS SUPPORT SHOULD BE SEEN AS ?ART OF THE COMPLETION OF THE TASK OF ENDING T88 APARTHEID CRIME AGAINST HUMINITY BY HELPING US TO DISMANTLE THE AEARTHEID SYSTEM AND LIQUIDATING ITS DESTRUCTIVE CONSEQUENCES.

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WE WOULD THEREFORE URGE THIS ORGANISATION TO TAKE THE NECESSARY DECISIONS AND MAKE THE RELEVANT PREPARATIONS WHICH WILL ENABLE IT TO ENTER THIS AREA 0? ACTIVITY AS SOON AS THE SITUATION PERMITS. WE WOULD ARGUE THAT YOUR DIRECT INTERVENTION WILL BE NECESSARY AS SOON AS WE ESTABLISH THE INTERIM GOVERNMENT TO WHICH WE HKVE REFERRED.

AS WAS AGREED EARLIER, THE UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSION FOR REFUGEES HAD TO INTERVENE BEFORE THIS TO ASSIST IN THE PROCESS OF TEE REPATRIATION OF EXILES. WE ARE VERY PLEASED THAT THE UNHOR HAS NOW SET ITSELP UP IN THE COUNTRY.

WE ARE ALSO KEENLY INTERESTED THAT THE UNHOR SHOULD HELP US TO RESETTLE THESE RETURNEES. TRIS IS GOING TO REQUIRE CONSIDERABLE RESOURCES, ESPECIALLY IN THE LIGH& OF THE FACT THAT THE OVERWHELMING MAJORITY OF THESE HAVE TO BE REINTEGRATED WITH URBAN COMMUNITIES.

WE THEREFORE RENEW OUR APPEAL BOTH TO THIS ORGANISATION AND ITS MEMBER STATES TO EXTEND GENEROUS ASSISTANCE TO THE UNHCR TO ENABLE I? Tq CARRY OUT TEIS VERY SENSITIVE HUMANITARIAN PROGRAMME. IN THIS REGARD, WE HOPE TKAT T33 UNHCR WILL RECEIVE SUCK ASSISTANCE FROM OTHER AGENCIES OF THE UNITED NATIONS AS IT MAY NEED TO ENABLZZIT TO CARRY OUT ITS TASKS PROPERLY. MR. PRESIDENT:

PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT;

STRENGTHENING AND DEMOCRATISING THE INSTITUTION OF THIS ORGANISATION TO ESSURE TEA? IT PLAYS ITS ROLE AS ONE OF THE PRINCIPAL ARCHITECTS OF THAT NEW WORLD ORDER. THE WORLD IS BECOMING EVER MORE INTERDEPENDENT. WHAT EACH ONE OF US DOES AS AN INDEPENDENT NATION IMPACTS ON OTHERS.
