


Finally, you are here-by requested to further furnish the National Youth Secretariat (NYS) with progress reports in this regard before the 10th December 1988.

GUIDELINES:

The 1st International Preparatory Committee meeting in Nov. 1987 accepted the proposal of the Socialist Working Youth League of Korea to host the 13th WFYS in their country in the Summer of 1989. The proposal was supported by the majority of the participants from National, Regional and International Youth and Students Organisations including the ANC Youth Section. Subsequently, the 2nd IPC took place in New Delhi; India where a Provisional Working Group was set-up to co-ordinate the preparatory work between the 2nd and 3rd IPC earmarked for November 1988. The slogan of the Festival remains "FOR ANTI-IMPERIALIST SOLIDARITY, PEACE AND FRIEND-SHIP".

Driven by the desire to fully participate alongside other progressive and democratic youth formations in the 13th WFYS the National Youth Secretariat(NYS)has therefore set - up the National Preparatory Committee (NPC).

THE NPC SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING TASKS

- To co-ordinate all Preparatory Work of the Festival.
- To monitor progress made on the implementation of guidelines for our preparations through visits to and reports from regions;
- To liaise with all relevant departments of the Movement on the Festival;
- To maintain dynamic contact with the IPC and its structures including contacts with WFDY, PYM, IUS, etc.
- To issue a regular News Letter entitled (Festival Bulletin) on the preparations.

The state of the s

- To keep the NYS informed on all developments relating to the Festival Movement.
- To keep the Leadership informed about its work and developments through the S.G.O.

COMPOSITION.

The NPC shall be composed of the following:

- (i) Deputy-Secretary of the ANC Youth Section
- (ii) Assistant-Secretary for International Affairs and
 - (iii) One elected member from the three (3) main centres where ANC Youth are found Zambia, Tanzania and Angola.
 - (iv) The Committee shall include the representative of the National Pioneer Committee.

The Deputy-Secretary of the Youth Section shall be the Con-venor of the NPC.

The NPC for the 13th WFYS shall be a special Sub-Committee of the NYC/NYS and account to these.

2. REGIONAL PREPARATORY COMMITTEES.

The RPC shall have the following tasks:-

- To co-ordinate all preparatory work in the region.
- To ensure implementation of all guidelines for preparatory work.
- Liaise with the NPC of Host Country on Festival Matters.
- To solicit for and suggest areas of participation of the region in the Festival.
- To report to the NPC and copy the RYC on all matters relating to the Festival.

COMPOSITION.

The Regional Preparatory Committee shall be composed of the following:

The Regional Preparatory Committee (RPC) for the 13th WFYS shall be a special Sub-Committee of the RYC and accounts to it.

POLITICAL MOBILISATION PROGRAMME:

The basis for mobilising our youth for the Festival shall include:

(i) "For Anti-Imperialist Solidarity, Peace and Friendship." Discussions, Round-Tables, Competitions etc., should be organised around the solgan of the Festival, emphasis being put on the meaning it has on the South African Revolution.

(ii) The Nuclear Threat

- The origins, lessons of the conflict that led to the bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki.
- The Nuclear capability of South Africa and the langer it poses to the world.
- The role of the youth in the struggle for global peace and for National Liberation.

(iii) Economic and Developmental Washes:

- Deformed Economic patterns in developing countries, causes and possible solutions (short and long-term).
 - TNC's and the protection of the Environment.
 - Technological revolution and the struggle for jobs.
 - NIEO an integral part of the anti-imperialist struggle.
 - Interrelation between the struggle for global peace/disarmament and the struggle for development.
