

HOUSING COMMITTEE

Meeting held on the 10th May 1984.

Present: Farida, Nelson, George, Leslie, Kentrige, Chris and Enos.

Apologies: Mandla Pule.

Cde Enos started the meeting by introducing comrades Nelson and George Stevens who are going to work with him.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted. The allocation list was discussed mainly the committee dealt with the Double-up list. The Housing Committee stressed the question of following the allocations as they appear on the list. This means, all the comrades who have been promised to occupy Double-up 15 to 20 should be accommodated in these houses. Cde Enos made an appeal to all the comrades, members of the committee to help comrade George to implement the short-term plan for the Double-up's.

Reports from Sub-Committees.

Somafeco: Cde Leslie reported that the problem at the Ngalo's still need some attention. Cde Enos explained the cause of the problem in that house and he said the Residence Committee should be very careful when attending to this problem.

Cde Ma-Mercy complaint in the Residence Committee about the accommodation of Nomonde Mtambo. The Chairperson responded by saying the members of the committees should read the Housing Guidelines. The guidelines state that accommodation will be given to comrades who are ACTIVELY contributing to the development on the Complex.

The Residence Committee asked the Chairperson to assist them in fixing the security light behind Unit One, Block Three Dormitories.

Copenhagen

Cde Farida asked the committee how best it can help the Sub-Committees to solve the problem of HOARDING FOOD IN THE BEDROOMS in some of the residences. The committee responded by saying this was a political problem and the political structures should be asked to help in solving this problem. Our people should learn to share, whatever we get should be distributed equally. The committee in Copenhagen will elect two members to substitute Cde Busi and Kays.

Tabora

Cde Chris said Tabora is a special place with special problems which are different from other areas. He appealed for a closer co-operation between the Housing Officer and the Tabora Residence Committee.



Ilala

The chairperson reported that there were no serious problems in his area.

General

The problem existing in house number Five in Tabora was discussed. Cde Enos explained that the problem of Cds Martin and Ndileka was referred to the RPC because of its political nature.
