

**THORNYCROFT, Sir Hamo (1850—1925) English School**

b. London, d. Oxford. Sculptor of monumental figure groups and realistic genre. Entered the R.A. and obtained the Sculpture Gold Medal in 1875. Exhibited at the R.A. from 1872; A.R.A. 1881, R.A. 1888. Knighted in 1917.

**VAN WOUW, Anton (1862—1945) South African School**

b. Driebergen, Holland, and trained at the Rotterdam Academy. Came to South Africa in 1890 and settled in Pretoria. In 1937 received the Sculpture Award from the South African Academy for Arts and Science.
