PROGRAMME FOR FUNCTION

The chairman of the board must be asked to address the donors' function and the executive director should give a report too. It was also suggested and agreed that the YEP director should also say something to the donors about this project to ensure their continued support.

The function for the beneficiaries will have a speaker followed by an opportunity for people to raise and share their feelings about the closure of the trust, (if any) before they are presented with the official proposed plan of action for closure by the Trust. In this way most of the beneficiaries' concerns and anxieties could then be addressed.

It was agreed that regions outside the FNV should also be informed of the closure through group meetings. Cot and Mohamed will deal with this task. They will also have to contact representatives of the various organisations we worked through in the regions and ask them to convene such meetings. We briefly discussed the question of the recording of the history and a timeline of the Trust. It was agreed that we need to commission a writer to do this. Barbara was to speak to Mr. L. Muthloate for suggestions of people to approach. Mohamed circulated a letter received from Ms. Ham at SACK commending the Trust on the role it has played in the repatriation process. Organisations such as the SACK which supported the Trust in accomplishing its mission should be invited to the donors' function.

This sub-committee will meet on 15/17 on 18th November at 8:00 am before the joint BT/YEP meeting. The minutes will be reported on progress so far.
