PREAMBLE

Mr W.S. H Molenco Chair peror.

Whereas in every community of human beings there may be detected seem form, however rude, of regulating authority, which determines in some degree, however slight, the relations of the members of the community with one another: And whereas the forms and functions of this authority are as diverse as the times and places in which these communities are found ; and whereas we, members of the community of South Africa convinced that far us to contest, test, sould and reject the present existing social ideas, beliefs, epiniens, aims, laws and ebjectives should meet and legally form a Pelitical party.

We therefore proclaim surselves a political party.

THE NAME OF THE PARTY WILL BE HIANGAMANT PROPIES PARTY

The Party will have three levels namely The Branches; The Regions ; The Matienal The Branches will be fermed by 200 members in an area.

A Region will be formed by three or more branches.

The National will be formed by 2 members elected from every Region.

At the head of the National there will be a President elected by a full house of the National Body. The house will further elect his deputy; Secretary; Minute Secretary; Treasury; four executive counittee members.

all efficials of the Farty will be elected by Sallet (secrete veting) GORDUCTED by a neutral many who will have been neminated and agreed upon by the whole house concer--ned. The whole election process will follow democratic standards.

The President will see to it that the prestige and the integrity of the Party is kept intact.

The running of the Party will not be a one-man's show but the active concern of all the administrative bedy and members of the Party as such.

The President will use his preregative where need be.

At no time will anybedy enter or commit the Party into any contract with any perman, association etc. without the concern of the President and the Administrative Bedy,

The Deputy will act in the absence of the President.

Secretaries at different levels will see to it that the records of the Party are up-te-date,

The treasury will keep an henest record of the finances of the Party.

A Financial Year will be decided upon by the National and only audited financial

statements will be accepted.

And with the branches it will be at the Mass Meeting when new effice-bearers are elected. Regions and Branches elections will be yearly; National every three years. In times of crisis the President will have the right to freeze the finances of the Farty and instruct the Treasury to give a Financial Statement before the Beard Of Impury slected by The National er at & Mess Meeting. Nebedy ence arrested, presecuted and found guilty for original effences except for

his pelitical beliefs shall be eligible for election to any effice in the Party. AT Branch level the precedure for the election of the office-bearers will be the same :

Chair-personinis Deputy; The Secretary ; The Minute Secretary ; The Treasury; and four Committee Members (this will further be determined by the size of the Branch in that area.).

The Four Committee-members will serve as co-ordinators unless a provision for

this effice has already been made.

Membership of the Party shall be sought by paying an amount as shall have been fixed:by the Party. On payment of this amount/fee the individual shall be issued with the membership card. Membership epop only to adults from 18 years upward. This fee will then be sent to the Region. The Region will in turn send a certain percentage of the money received to the Branch for the maintenance of that Branch.

Each Branch shall send as many members to the Region as shall be determined by The National. The Region shall be formed by elected members from various Branches. The Branches will have a right to device means of raising funds. In times of crisis the Branches will appeal to the Region and if a Region fails te ceme up with acceptable selution to the problems the matter will then be

P.3 referred to The National where a final binding decission will be taken. The Chair-person in consultation with the other effice-bearers will look after the life of the Branch.

The members of the Party have a right to guiry emermalies cited in the Party by a written note clearly out-laying such complaints to the secretary through the co-ordinator or his representative in the Branch.

Misbehavisur in the Party may cause one a suspension of not more than a year. or a complete expulsion from the Party. Under all discussionees justice will always take its full course.

Mabehavieur/Misconduct at the meetings own cause a member suspension from the mesting.

Decissions taken by a unanimous asjerity shell be binding. Members of The National can be elected from both The Regions and The Branches. The Region shall have a Chair-person plan Beynty | The Secretary | The Minute Secretary | The Treasury and six or more members of the secretary the secretary te represent the Branches equally.
