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G TO DISCUSS SUPPLIES AND CATERING NEEDS. D. Ma 31 82.

Present: Cds. Gaboo, Mabaruti, .Tanda, Motsumi, R. Hodgson.

1. A telex received from London requested urgently, a list of catering requirements for the school. Agreed to send this together with needs for the butchery and the Charlottes. List is attached.

Student meals - It was generally felt that the students are the worse off, since the workers who eat at Ilala get meat meals 4 times during the week at lunch, and also 4 meat meals at home in the evening. Likewise, the SOMAFCO staff and catering staff at the school, primary and nursery schools, also get the benefit of two meat meals on meat days.

The students only get 5 meat meals a week. It was therefore

- decided that the students meat intake be increased to 6

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and the workers reduced in by one.

Other suggestions for increasing protein intake was the purchase of red beans and lentils.

To break the monotony of the diet it would also be helpful to have a spaghetti meal twice monthly and for workers and others once per month.

Regular stocks of charcoal would enable the school to make bread a couple of times per week. It was agreed that a letter be sent to the Site Office requesting that once a week, the truck returning workers to town, should proceed from Kihonda to purchase charcoal. This should be done on Tuesday or Wednesday. Mompoti should accompany the driver. Also early Sunday mornings, a truck should be made available for the same purpose and twice monthly after purchasing on Sunday, deliveries to be made to the residences.

The school be approached to consider a once monthly collection of fuel to be cut up by the students, also to be used as fuel.

Squash should be eliminated from the menus and replaced by fresh fruit.

The Charlottes should get more and varied fruit. Where there are very young babies, extra sugar should be supplied for the cooking of hard fruits and for the babies porridge. Liver should also be purchased and supplied to babies.

Bulk supplies for the school should be given once per month, Mabaruti to investigate storage space for this. All additional purchases of foodstuffs to be done via Tanda.

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stocktaking and record cards to be introduced to bulk and distribution stores. There should always be a months supply in the distribution depot. '

Comrades Motsumi and Hodgson to do an inventory of stocks in bulk store, Cd. Tends to work out monthly requirements for distribution store. Then to gauge what stocks required for say 3 or 6 months supply of all necessities,
