## **CPM**

- The CPM planned for Port Shepstone was called off due to;
  - The Reed Dance
  - rising level of violence in the area
  - security risk involved to the CA staff members
- A team comprising Tom, Tango and Nickey Le Roux was tasked to oversee the plan of action to effectively cancel the meeting
- These included a briefing meeting with the MP's to advise them of the cancellation
- Media announcements re. cancellation of the meeting were made on Radio Zulu and Radio Metro
- A consultative meeting to explain to the community leaders the reason for the cancellation of the meeting was called off as it coincided with a peace conference held in Durban
- The project manager visited the Durban SACS regional office and had a meeting with Jan Henning and Johan Louw. They agreed that;
  - The alleged dereliction of duty by the SACS personal be investigated in order to improve future relations and practices
  - The project manager introduced the CEP coordinators to the current monitors ie. Mary de Haas

## Provincial Liaison

- The Provincial Liaison Section of the CL visited two provincial legislatures (Northern Province and Eastern Cape). The aim was to;
  - Introduce our CEP coordinators
  - To request their cooperation and assistance for the CA rural outreach programme
