Through Mr. Sobizana Mnqikana of your Stockholm office we have been informed that you have accepted our invitation to give a speech at the hearing on South Africa which we have arranged in Copenhagen on March 17 and 18 in co-operation with the Solidarity Fund of the Workers' Movement, the Danish UN Association, the Danish Youth Council and the South Africa Committees of Copenhagen and Aarhus.

From the enclosed programme you can see that we would like to suggest that your speech be scheduled so as to follow immediately after the opening address by the Prime Minister of Denmark. We have, tentatively, given your speech a heading which, we hope, will not be felt restrictive in any way.

In consultation with Mr. Mnqikana we have suggested that Mr. Dan Tloome, member of the ANC delegation, could speak in a panel together with a representative of the SWAPO. I do not know whether this would conflict with the remaining part of your programme in Denmark, so I would indeed appreciate your reaction to our suggestion.

The hearing is planned as a Danish introduction to the start of the International Anti-apartheid Year on March 21. Your presence will add immensely to the impact we are aiming at through the hearing, and we wish to express our deep appreciation of your willingness to assist us in our efforts to achieve that impact on Danish public opinion.
