A BRIEF REPORT ABOUT THE OUT-COME OF THE MEETING HELD ON THE 15TH JUNE 11284.

1.1 The meeting was opened by reading a report covering a period of three months.

1.2 Points highlighted by the report were as follows:-

(a) Poor attendance of students and staff.

(b) General activities of the community which resulted to the poor attendance.

(c) Constant meetings of various departments of which our staff is drawn;1

(d) Organising of permanent teachers.
