According to press releases appearing on 31 August 1993, applications to present oral evidence before the Commission must be in your hands before 13 September 1993.


This Association therefore respectfully wishes to make application to present further oral evidence before the Commission in support of its written submission entitled "Motivation Why East Griqualand Should Remain Part of Region E (Natal)", with particular reference to points 1.1 to 1.10 of the Resolution by the Planning Committee to the Negotiating Council Meeting of 28 May 1993 on the Commission of Regions/States/Provinces.

From Item 3 on the attached copy, you will note that 15 copies of our documents were submitted to the Commission on 17 June 1993. Please advise if further copies are required.

Finally, it is this Association's firm belief that the hearings now being arranged should be held in the East Griqualand area (Kokstad). In terms of Item 2.1 of the Resolution on the Report of the Commission on the Delimitation/Demarcation of Regions and the Way Forward, adopted by the Negotiating Council on 9 August 1993, it is impractical to expect the Commission to receive (widespread) oral evidence in respect of the sensitive (East Griqualand) area outside of the area.


