SUMMARY DISMISSAL - HEALTH ASSISTANT'S SCHOOL
IRINGA

The school disciplinary committee on its meeting held on 24th January, 1987 found you guilty of breaking school regulations as follows:-

- (1) Visiting females hostel without permission
- (2) Taking away Veronica's clothes by force and without her consent on 19th January, 1987.
- (3) Beating Veronica Kiama on 18th January, 1987 within the school compound.
- (4) Your love affairs with Veronica has threatened the peace within school campus through the act of beating her and entering her room sometimes by force.
- (5) Committing another offence after a suspension (see my letter ref. No. HAS/IR/CONF.1/44 dated 2nd June, 1986).

The committee also dealt at length concerning Veronica clothes which you took by force. By agreeing yourself that you had bought her those clothes and gave her as her property, the committee unanimously agreed that the said clothes belong to Veronica. They should therefore, be returned to her by the authority. If you do not agree to this ruling you are allowed to take further measures to recover the clothes by reporting the matter to the police. The committee were really disappointed by this type of behaviour.

According to school regulations such breaches constitutes either a suspension or summary dismissal. As you had already been suspended once the Committee decided to take a tougher action by giving you a summary dismissal from the school with immediate effect on receiving this letter.

You will be given a warrant to Dar es Salaam where the Ministry of Health and Social Welfare will deliberate on the question and give its final ruling. You are also allowed to appeal to the Ministry through this committee, in case you are not satisfied with the ruling of the committee.
