## Letter to Prime Minister of India\*

The Vorster regime intends this year to impose yet another new constitution upon the people, with the aim of incorporating the Coloured and Indian minorities as second class allies of the ruling whites in opposition to the African majority. True to their tradition, established by Mahatma Gandhi, Indian South Africans have rejected all the blandishments and bribes of Vorster and have continued to stand as they have always done, for justice and equality for all South Africans, For steadfastly maintaining their solidarity with the African people many have been detained, sentenced to long terms of imprisonment, tortured and killed,, They have been strengthened, as we are, by the knowledge that they have the full support of the Government and people of India. We are confident that the Government of India would not give its support or lend credibility to any individual or group that sought special privileges for itself and collaborated with the apartheid regime

and India go back into the last century, and have been sustained. It is India that took the first initiatives to mobilise international opinion against the racist policies of Pretoria, and India that alone and unilaterally cut off trade and economic links with South Africa.

Now\* in 1978\* the year designated as the year against apartheid, we\* are in the final stages of cutting off all political, military economic and moral assistance and totally isolating the apartheid regime.
